

Miners Ravine Trail - Roseville

Thursday, January 8, 2026

Difficulty: Easy

Elevation Gain: About 250 feet

Hike Distance : Approximately 6.2 mile loop on paved bike trails. Remember to share the road with the bikers.

Pace : Moderate/Relaxed

Hike Description: This is a hidden treasure through beautiful landscape including numerous majestic oak trees and approximately 5 interesting foot bridges. Expect to see the native birds and animals alongside the active creek. After a short rain when the water level is higher, expect to see salmon in the creek beds.

Considered a Suburban hike, the trail starts at the parking lot at Miners Ravine at Sierra College Blvd. Walk up to the Sculpture Park, have a snack and return to the parking lot.

For those interested, we can grab lunch at La Bou on Douglas and Sierra College Blvd then head home.

Travel Time /Distance: 12 miles about 20 minutes. This is a \$3.00 driver donation .

Facilities: No restrooms on the trail.

Special Notes

1. **Bring a copy of your ID (driver's license), Health Card, and an emergency contact name and phone number with you when you hike.**
2. If you have any health issues, please consider your condition before hiking.
3. Always bring 2 pairs of shoes, along with a plastic bag to store your muddy/dusty hiking boots after the hike. DO NOT get your driver's car dirty by wearing your dirty boots on the drive home.

Heavy rain cancels the hike.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: Drive to Miners Ravine Trail Parking lot on Sierra College Blvd.

Exit the parking lot at Orchard, Turn Right on to Dell Web Blvd. Turn Left at Stoneridge. Left at Twelve Bridges. Right on to Sierra College Blvd. Continue Sierra College and turn right into the parking lot at Miners Ravine (Shortly after you pass Secret Ravine Parkway on the right). The lot is small with limited parking space.
