CANYON VIEW TRAIL TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2024

DIFFICULTY: Easy

ELEVATION CHANGE: Some easy ups and downs. Starting elevation, approx. 1200 ft.

HIKE DISTANCE: Between 3 and 4 miles

GENERAL LOCATION: Auburn

DESCRIPTION: A short drive and a short, but beautiful hike. The Preserve was purchased by Placer Land Trust in 2003 and the 1st trails opened in 2013. The area is full of oaks, pines, a tiny stream and a brief view of the Sierras. The trails are packed dirt and dip into canyons so there are some gradual downs and ups. We will start the hike with a 30 minute hike beside the Auburn Canal. We will have a snack break to get fueled up for the ascent back to the cars.

TRAVEL TIME/DISTANCE: 30 minutes driving time and 16 miles one way. A donation of \$4 is suggested for riders. Driving directions — see below and print before coming to the hike, if driving.
