East Perimeter Trail and North Nature Loop Tahoe Donner Tuesday, July 8, 2025

GENERAL LOCATION: Tahoe Donner, Truckee, CA

DIFFICULTY: Moderate/Strenuous

HIKE DISTANCE: 7.4 miles loop hike

ELEVATION/GAIN: Start 6191 / Highest 6605 / Gain 1102

PACE: Moderate to fast depending on group make-up

TRAIL CONDITIONS: A few rocky uphill spots but mostly packed earth trail.

DESCRIPTION: This is a lovely hike with a lot of diversity, Alder Creek, wetlands,

lovely vistas, gorgeous pines, aspens and wonderful Tahoe air, a little

of everything.

FACILITIES: We will come by a lodge with restroom facilities toward the later part

of the hike. There are restrooms at the Shell Station right when you exit the freeway and that would be a good place to stop before getting

to the meet up spot.

DRIVE TIME/MILES: Time and distance to trailhead 90 minutes approximately 80 miles

DONATION: Suggested donation to drivers: \$16

MEET/LEAVE TIME: Meet 6:30 am and leave 6:45 am

Meet at far end of Orchard Creek Parking Lot in front of Fitness

center, rows 12-14.

PREPARATION FOR HIKE:

- Being prepared physically as well as having the right equipment makes for a better experience, not only for you, but for your fellow hikers.
- If you have any health issues, please consider your condition before hiking at high altitude or at a fast pace.

What to Bring:

- PLENTY OF WATER! Recommend 50 oz. /1.5 liters minimum for 5-mile hike more if longer. Electrolytes suggested. Higher altitudes are dehydrating even when cool.
- Hiking boots/shoes, hat, sun protection, insect repellant, small first aid kit. Wind/rain
 jacket always advisable in the mountains. Trekking poles recommended.
- ID (driver's license), health insurance card, emergency contact / phone number.
- Extra pair of shoes to change into after hike and a plastic bag for muddy/dusty hiking boots to keep your driver's car clean.
